ROUGH CUTS Festival

ROUGH CUTS is a yearly festival with a curated platform for choreographic works, installations and performances (up to 30 min) that has since 2011 included workshops, exhibitions and residency programs for artistic research and creation. The **ROUGH CUTS Festival** is a project of **ID_Frankfurt / Independent Dance e.V.**, a non-profit association for freelancing professionals involved in the creation, research and dissemination of results in the field of choreography and performance.

Residency time: ID_Frankfurt will provide working spaces for up to 5 weeks to artists wishing to present their work within the frame of the festival. During this period, different activities could take place according to participants initiatives, wishes and needs.

Venues: This year the festival will be hosted by two different venues: **Frankfurt LAB** and the art gallery **Platform SARAI**. The technical set up will be restricted. Please see information about the venues under: www.roughcuts.org!!

Eligibility: Every format will be considered (**performances, installations, stage works, lectures, exhibitions or other**). However, works to be presented on stage should not exceed 30 minutes.

You can apply with:

- **an existing work to be presented within the frame of the ROUGH CUTS Festival;**
- **an existing idea/method/work you have already explored/practiced/presented to work on further during the residency time in Frankfurt and present within the frame of the ROUGH CUTS Festival.**

Fee: A maximum of 3 people per project will be remunerated up to €1000.- each.
